- b. The Nature Conservancy Trail Marking & Update. Completed. Junction points to be tagged later.
- c. HSV Bicycle Trails Plan. Laurie will be talking to road bikers.
- d. Tree Identification on Trails. Paul reported on options for tags. QR codes possible. So far he has found about 55 species of trees.
- e. Dog Off-Leash. Garland and Saline ordinances do not allow dogs off leash on any trails. This agenda item is closed.
- f. Water Trails. Laurie and Stacy will talk with Brad Meredith regarding Lake Pineda.
- g. Waste bags and Trash cans. Received a request from a Recreation Committee member about adding doggie waste bags and trash cans to the trails. Committee members were asked to inventory waste cans when they inventory benches (see 8.a. above). Valerie will get costs of dog bags and holders.

## 10. New Business

- a. Trails Master Plan. Will be working on that in November. Well go over things at our September meeting. Need up to 3 committee members to assist with this -- Paul, Laurie, Barbara
- b. Walk for Cancer. September 30. Balboa Spillway and Hernando Trail. Small signs will be put up, for a day. Dogs will be allowed, on leash. Need trails to be in great shape. Last year about 400-450 people participated. Police will help in parking lots and for crossing road. Charlie will find out about status of the new trail extension. Melanie will walk that trail soon and keep in touch with Charlie.

11. Questions/Comments. Paul is interested in traffic counts on various trails. Game cameras are on sale right now, which could be set low at foot level. Are we interested? We'll follow up with Stacy.
