



HSV RV PARK INFORMATION AND RULES

Hot Springs Village RV Park is a private park for members and sponsored guests, located in a serene rural setting on Lake Coronado in Hot Springs Village, Arkansas. It sits within 26,000 acres of pristine lakes, beautiful golf courses, beaches, hiking, kayaking, restaurants, and much more including a performing arts center. Hot Springs Village is located only twenty minutes north of Hot Springs National Park. The park has ten pull-through sites available only for use by self-contained recreational vehicles having their own toilet and waste water holding tanks. Guest are welcome with a member sponsorship. Member's number is required with reservation. Non-sponsored guests interested in Hot Springs Village may contact Village Homes and Land Sales office (501-922-5560) for sponsorship opportunities. The RV Park is open year round with electrical and water hookups. Grills and picnic tables are provided at each site. There are no restrooms or other facilities at the park. A central dump station is provided for use by registered guests. A daily rental fee is charged and reservations are required. Sites are first-come first-serve and are not assigned. Call the Ponce de Leon Center at 501.922.4231 to make reservations. RV payments are final and nonrefundable.

1. RV sites are available to Hot Springs Village members for a maximum of 14 nights. Additional nights may be approved by the Lifestyle and Outdoor Recreation Manager. Sponsored guest may occupy sites for a maximum of seven nights. After maximum number of nights, RV's must vacate the park for 14 days before returning.
2. RV's must register at the Ponce de Leon Center between the hours of **9:00 am** and **2:00 pm**, Monday through Friday.
3. Late arrivals (after 2:00pm) must register the next business day.
4. Grills and picnic tables are provided for your convenience.

5. Pets must be restrained and under owner control at all times outside of the RV. Owners are required to clean up after their pets.
6. A dump station is provided for discharging of gray and black water tanks. Discharging on the ground or any place other than the dump station is strictly prohibited.
7. Damage to common property, such as cutting trees or picking wild flowers, is prohibited.
8. For the enjoyment of all guest, quiet hours are between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.
9. Washing vehicles in the park is prohibited.
10. A trash dumpster is provided on site. All trash must be deposited in the dumpster.
11. Towels and swim clothing only is allowed on drying lines.
12. RV units must supply their own adapters for electricity and water. Tampering with utility outlets is not permitted. If a utility does not operate properly, contact the Ponce de Leon Center for assistance.
13. Guest rates apply unless member is occupying the camp site overnight.
14. An above ground contained fire pit may be used. Fires must be extinguished before retiring for the night.
15. External generators are not allowed in the park.
16. All sites must be kept clean and orderly. All trash must be kept bagged.
17. Vehicle repair or maintenance is not allowed in the RV park. Contact the Ponce de Leon Center to request an emergency vehicle repair authorization.
18. Music may be played only loud enough to be heard at your site.
19. Vehicle parking is allowed on your rented site only.

*****HSV POA staff have full authority to enforce all park rules and regulations.***

NOTE: Please report any suspicious vehicles or persons in the park to the HSV Police Department. The hiking trail at the RV park ends at the Coronado Complex, which includes the tennis, fitness and community centers and library.
